

Travel Grant Program

Synopsis

Coalition to Cure Calpain 3 (C3) will award Travel Grants to foster early career investigators who are currently conducting preclinical or clinical research in the area of calpainopathy (also known as Limb Girdle Muscular Dystrophy Type 2A or LGMD2A).

The grants support travel expenses to attend relevant conferences and meetings to present the investigator's ongoing work.

Guidelines

- Preference will be given to early stage investigators, defined as an investigator who has completed their terminal degree within the past 10 years. Postdoctoral researchers are eligible to apply.
- Open to investigators from laboratories not currently funded under C3 Research Grants program.
- Investigators may not receive more than one C3 Travel Grant per project.
- Investigator must have been selected to present, regardless of format, on calpainopathy or Calpain 3 at a major meeting.
- Grant will be provided after the meeting, with reimbursement of expenses up to \$1500.

Application materials

- Cover letter describing the nature of the project and meeting
- A resume or C.V.
- A copy of the accepted abstract, including abstract title, author(s), and text
- Confirmation of acceptance of abstract
- One letter of reference

Deadline
