



Travel Grant Program

Synopsis

Coalition to Cure Calpain 3 (C3) will award Travel Grants to foster early career investigators who are currently conducting preclinical or clinical research in the area of Limb Girdle Muscular Dystrophy Type 2A (LGMD2A, a form of calpainopathy).

The grants support travel expenses to attend relevant conferences and meetings to present the investigator's ongoing work.

Guidelines

- Preference will be given to early stage investigators, defined as an investigator who has completed their terminal degree within the past 10 years. Postdoctoral researchers are eligible to apply.
- Open to investigators from laboratories not currently funded under C3 Research Grants program.
- Investigators may not receive more than one C3 Travel Grant per project.
- Investigator must have been selected to present, regardless of format, on LGMD2A or Calpain 3 at a major meeting.
- Grant will be provided after the meeting, with reimbursement of expenses up to \$1500.

Application materials

- Cover letter describing the nature of the project and meeting
- A resume or C.V.
- A copy of the accepted abstract, including abstract title, author(s), and text
- Confirmation of acceptance of abstract
- One letter of reference

Deadline
